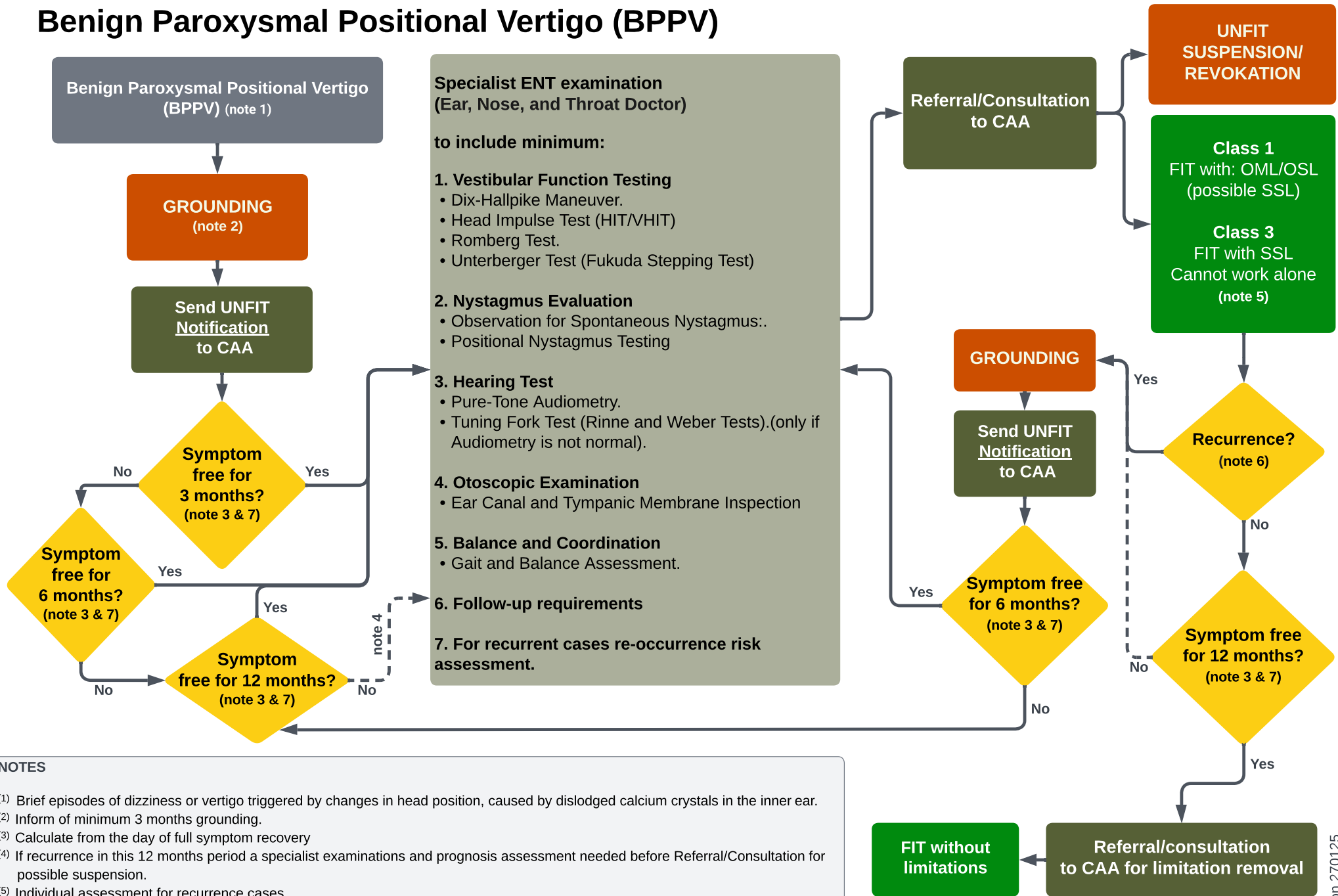


Benign Paroxysmal Positional Vertigo (BPPV)



NOTES

(1) Brief episodes of dizziness or vertigo triggered by changes in head position, caused by dislodged calcium crystals in the inner ear.

(2) Inform of minimum 3 months grounding.

(3) Calculate from the day of full symptom recovery

(4) If recurrence in this 12 months period a specialist examinations and prognosis assessment needed before Referral/Consultation for possible suspension.

(5) Individual assessment for recurrence cases.

(6) **If recurrence then immediate grounding and CAA notification. New 6 months symptom free period is required followed by new ENT examination and referral/consultation.**

(7) No documented recurrence. Documentation to include all medical records (Hospital/GP/Specialists)
