

AGREED MINUTES

A delegation representing jointly the Governments of the Kingdoms of Norway, Denmark and Sweden and a delegation representing the Government of the Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia met during ICAN2011 at Mumbai on 18 October 2011 to discuss civil aviation relations.

The talks were held in a friendly and cordial atmosphere.

The delegations are listed in appendix I and II.

The delegations agreed upon and initialled Air Services Agreements (ASA:s) between Ethiopia and Denmark, Norway and Sweden, respectively, as well as a MOU regarding the co-operation within Scandinavian Airlines System (SAS). These texts are attached as Appendices III and IV.

The delegations further agreed to recommend their respective competent authorities to initiate discussions on bilateral agreements on the avoidance of double taxation.

The delegations agreed that they would give immediate practical effect to the initialled ASA:s and the MOU, to the extent possible under national law, pending the entry into force of the three ASA:s and the MOU.
